Below are a few reminders for the month ahead...

If your child has his or her Valentines signed, sealed, and ready to deliver before the party day, please go ahead and send them early. We can have some friends pass theirs out the day before.
- As we all know, Kansas weather is so unpredictable this time of year. Gary Lezak's job is so tricky! We just wanted to remind everyone of the snow day policy. When Johnson County Catholic Schools (or Catholic Schools of Johnson County, depending on the channel you're watching) has cancelled school, there will be NO 4x4.
